**REMINDER**

Please be reminded of the following for the academic year 2018/2019:

- A written excuse signed by the parent/guardian **MUST** be provided when your child/ward is late or absent. Failure to present an excuse will result in your child/ward being sent back home to get one.
- Girls' skirts **MUST** be worn two inches (2') below the knee.
- Girls' **MUST** wear their school tie at all times and plain white socks two inches (2") above their shoes.
- Boys' **MUST** wear plain black socks and shoes.
- Boys' hair **MUST** be neatly cut-flat.
- **Boys' pants bottom width MUST be at least 18" wide (all around). NO skinny pants are allowed.**
- Students should wear **ONLY** plain white vests and t-shirts under their school shirts. Absolutely **NO** coloured undergarments.
- Both boys and girls **MUST** wear their school crest at all times.
- Students should **NOT** have electronic items, caps, rags and coloured belts on the school compound. Cell phones should be turned off at the gate on entry and should remain off during the school day. **The school not be held responsible for the lost any cell phone or any other item mentioned above.**
- **No visible tattoos; if any it must be covered.**
